It is physically impossible for a well-educated intellectual or brave man to make money the chief object of his thoughts : just as it is for him to make his dinner the principal object of him. All healthy people like their dinner, but dinner is not the main object of their life. So, all healthy people like making money, ought to like it, and enjoy the sensation of winning it, but the main object of their life is not

money; it is something better than money. A good soldier for instance, mainly wishes to do his fighting well. He is glad of his pay—very properly so, and justify grumbles when you keep him ten years without it—still his main notion of his life is to win battles, not to be paid for winning them. So of the doctors. They like fees, no doubt, ought to like them; yet if they are brave and well-educated, the entire object of their life is not fee. They on the whole desire to cure the sick, and if they are good doctors, and the choice were fairly put to them, they would rather cure their patient, and lose the fee than kill him and get it. And so with the other brave and rightly trained men; their work is first, their fee second; very important no doubt, but still second. But in every nation as I said, there are vast number of people, who are ill-educated, cowardly and more or less stupid. And with these people, just as certainly, the fee is first and the work second.

Properly planned and executed holidays can tone up both mind and body. But many of us do not know how to take holiday. Good planning is all important. A leading clinical psychologist reports that many people seek his help after poorly planned holiday that have led to family quarrels. Instead of making their holiday period of rest, development of understanding and love for their family, people try to block everything out with **fun-packed** activity. When the fun is over, they return in worse shape, mentally and physically, then when it began.

Here the other common holiday error which, as a doctor, I caution against : some of us delude ourselves into thinking that a quick holiday will give instant relaxation and get us back on the track. Most people need a full three weeks or longer. To get any lasting good out of your holiday, you must have a change

of pace and scene. This is one reason why travel can be so helpful. Thus spending your entire holiday at home may be a mistake. Another common error that tourist often make is trying to see and do far too much. To be able to live in peace and quiet for a time is a mark of maturity. It gives you a chance to think about your family and yourself.

A holiday's success is measurable by the results it produces. A good one is often marked by relaxed muscles, more satisfying sleep, slower heart rate and reduction in blood pressure.
